This statement is made pursuant to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (UK) and constitutes our modern slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending March 2022. The directors believe that due to the nature of our business 'slavery' is unlikely to be an issue for our suppliers. All goods are sourced from reputable suppliers and any supplier of services is subject to a due diligence process. Our standard supplier agreements insist upon compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (or its EU equivalent).

We have a whistleblowing policy for colleagues to use.
